Reservations Are Now Open!

We have begun taking reservations for the 2011 big game seasons. Call me at 303-460-0273 to reserve your spots for the 2010 big game seasons.



I want your feedback as soon as possible. I will work to get everyone confirmed and scheduled for all of our hunts no later than March 15. The time to plan your hunts for next year is now!

Please call me to discuss your choices and questions. If there is something you are looking for that's not on the list, please let me know what you are interested in. I will be evaluating several new options over the next few months. If I have a good idea of what you are looking for, I will keep you in mind for anything that comes up.

The sooner I can get your choices and understand the demand, the easier it will be for me to select new properties to lease for next year. You can change them as new properties come available if you'd like.

If you are interested in a hunt that requires preference points to draw, please let me know how many points you have. Members who have the necessary preference points to guarantee the drawing of a tag will be given priority over members who have only a chance of drawing a tag.

Guests will be allowed, but members take priority over guests! Hunt fees for guests will be higher than the fees listed for our members.

The best effort will be made to match groups with the right size property to fit the number of hunters.



Please be aware that when we match hunters to properties, we prioritize requests from buck and bull hunters over requests from doe and cow hunters. Hunters who are after a trophy buck or bull pay considerably higher rates than hunters who are after does or cows for the freezer, and those higher fees provide the funds that make our leasing operation possible.

That doesn't mean that we don't have plenty of opportunity for economical doe/cow hunts. Check out our new Wyoming property on page 20 for one example.

2011 Forecast

We are in good shape for 2011, with plenty of **deer** and **antelope** hunting available. We also have some very good **elk** hunting opportunities available, including an outstanding ranch located very close to Denver – check out COS760 on page 17 for more info.

We anticipate having only a very few landowner vouchers available. **It is very important that you apply in time and get your tag in the draws this year.**

Payments

To reserve a spot on the ranch of your choice, full payment of the hunt fee is required.

If you do not draw the tag you were expecting to draw for the reservation you have made, 100% of your payment will be refunded.

This property does have great potential for Elk and Mule Deer but it is not an easy property to hunt. There is a lot of dark timber and steep terrain.

Do not expect a monster elk, but elk up to the 300" class are in this area, with the possibility of something larger.

The mule deer can be very good on this ranch, but it will take some work to find them. The deer here just keep getting better each year. We harvested a nice 7x5 here in 2008, and plenty of up-and-coming bucks were spotted in 2009.

This property can produce some good elk hunting. We still have not utilized it to its full potential. It can be a tough rifle hunt during the regular seasons but with some patience and effort it will produce. We've taken bulls during archery season, which can be very good here in September depending on the conditions.

It has the potential to produce a trophy bull and also don't overlook the late cow seasons, many of which you can draw as your 2nd choice. The elk migrate here after the regular seasons and this is a great spot to shoot a cow later in the year.



This can be a physical hunt due to the terrain. We had a huge 8x8 bull on the property in 2008 and did not get him – maybe he will still be there this year?

The deer come up from the Platte River to feed in the corn. The best bet will be to hunt this property before or shortly after the corn is cut. The pressure of rifle season may also drive some deer to this property.

This could be a tough hunt, but with some patience and luck this might produce. We saw some good bucks here again this year.

This is also a great place to shoot a doe.

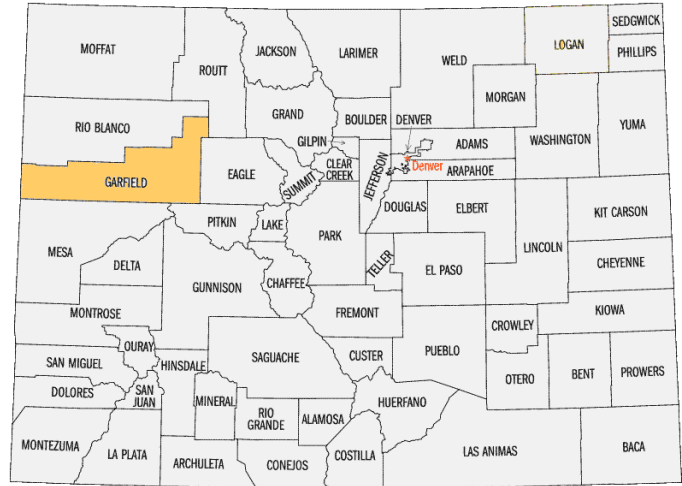
We will manage this carefully to continue to produce trophy bucks, but for next year there should be more trophies available to at least a couple of our hunters.

This property is in one of the best trophy mule deer Units in Colorado. The tags are not easy to get – but if you do get one, you stand a good chance of killing a big buck.

The success rate on deer here runs 90-95% and this property blocks off a lot of BLM ground.

If you have the points to draw one of these tags, I would recommend it. And, we should have a good chance of getting some landowner vouchers here.

This is not a cheap deer hunt compared to the rest of our options but it still represents a very good value based on what quality mule deer hunts go for here in Colorado.



There are few 30"+ bucks taken in this area just about every year. Lodging is available on the property. Elk can be good, generally later in the year.

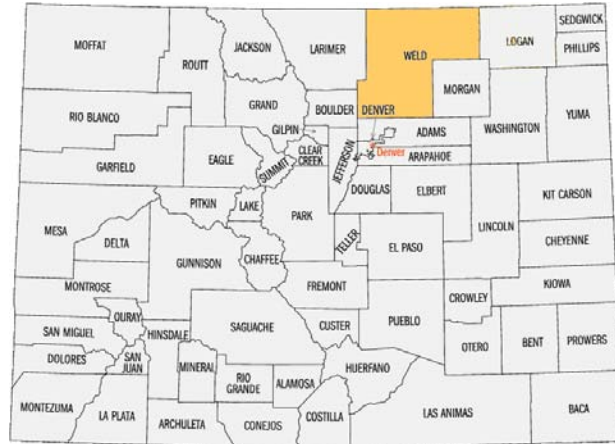
To allow the greatest possibility of success for our trophy buck hunters, we do not allow doe hunting on this property.

This is a small property, but one with lots of whitetail traffic. The owner of this property has a grape vineyard planted – as you can imagine, the deer are very attracted to the grapes!

In addition to the potential for trophy bucks, the owner has asked for our help in thinning out some whitetails in order to protect his grapes, and we’re looking for doe hunters to help him out. Need some venison for the freezer? You’re not going to find better tasting meat than **grape-fed whitetail venison!**

Due to the smaller size of this property, please be extra careful with your shot selection.

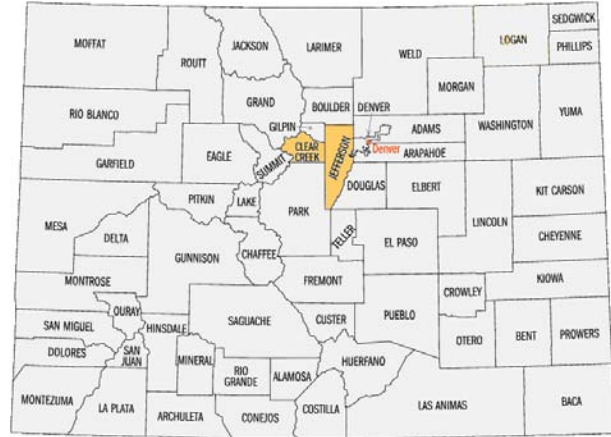

And if the healthy elk and deer populations aren't enough, this hunt will also include very comfortable **lodging**, complete with **satellite TV** and **high speed Internet!**

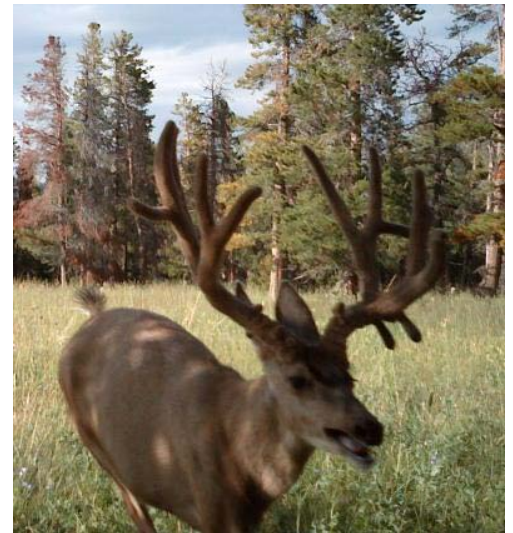
This property also offers bear hunting – the landowner lost a llama to a bear on this property within the past year, and is encouraging us to try to take
